Happy New Year! I am so proud of the impact we made in our community in 2024. Our first annual luncheon sold out quickly and was a wonderful afternoon of camaraderie and giving. It was a pleasure to introduce Good Friends of The First State to new supporters and share our mission.



Your generous donations enabled us to partner with organizations across all three counties, helping 44 women in crisis since May 2024!

This year also brought many other notable events. In October, we partnered with Rescue Spa Philadelphia and Kendra Scott Jewelry for a sip-and-shop event, raising over \$1,200, and in November, we were honored to receive a \$3,100 grant from Wilmington Women for Good. The Junior Committee hosted two bake sales raising over \$1,000 and wrote personal thank-you letters to our largest investors. We now have 16 middle and high school girls participating. We are proud to share this important work with the younger generation.

Looking ahead, we're excited for our next fundraiser on April 24th at Wilmington Country Club. Tickets will go on sale March 1, and seating will be capped at 200. If you'd like to purchase a table of 10, a block of 5, or individual tickets, please visit our website. We are focusing on increasing our efforts within our local community by surpassing last year's \$35,000 raised from 11 investors to be able to assist more women in need.
